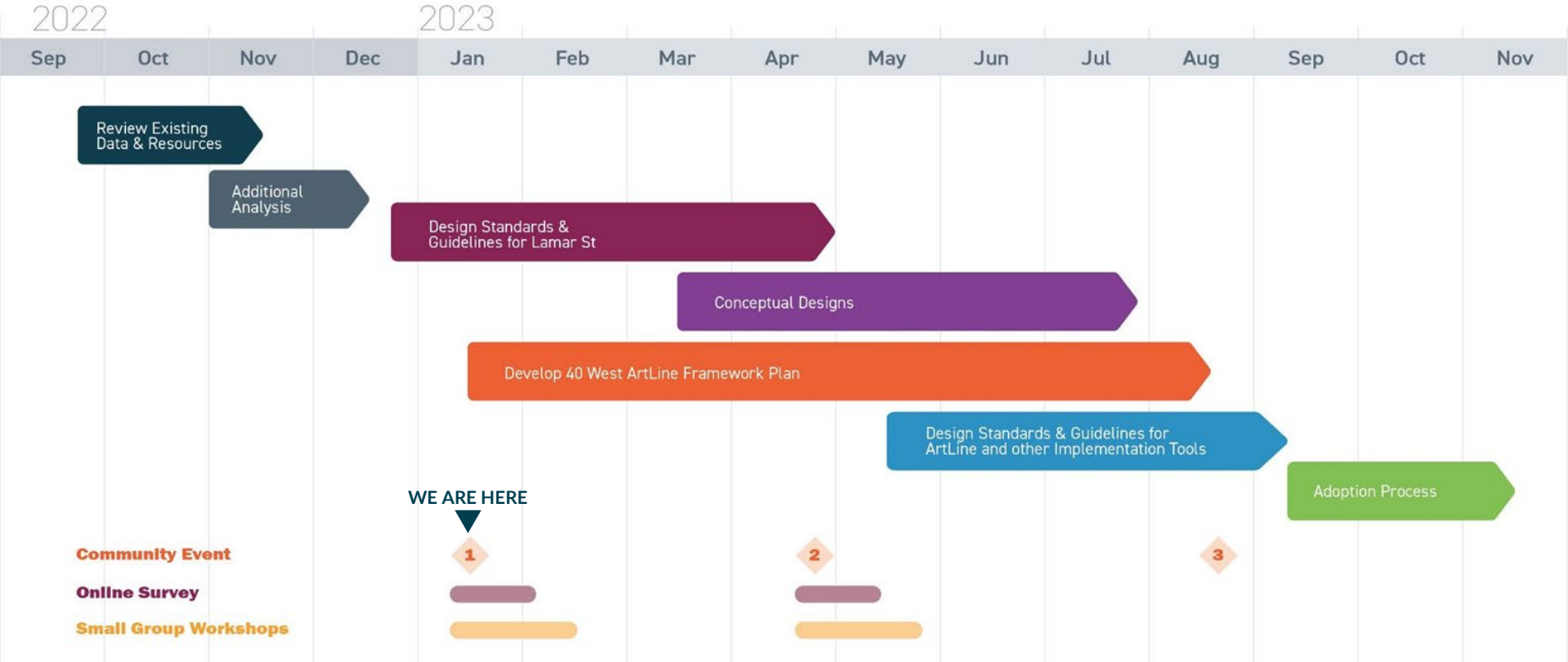


Project Scope

Community Engagement - Key Elements

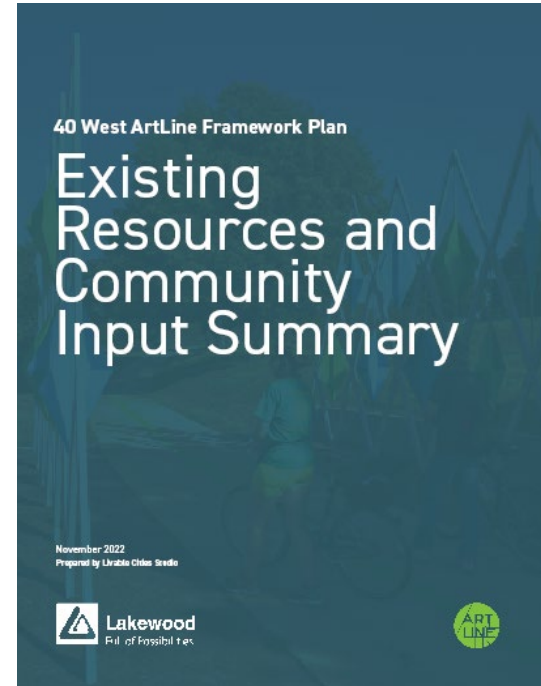

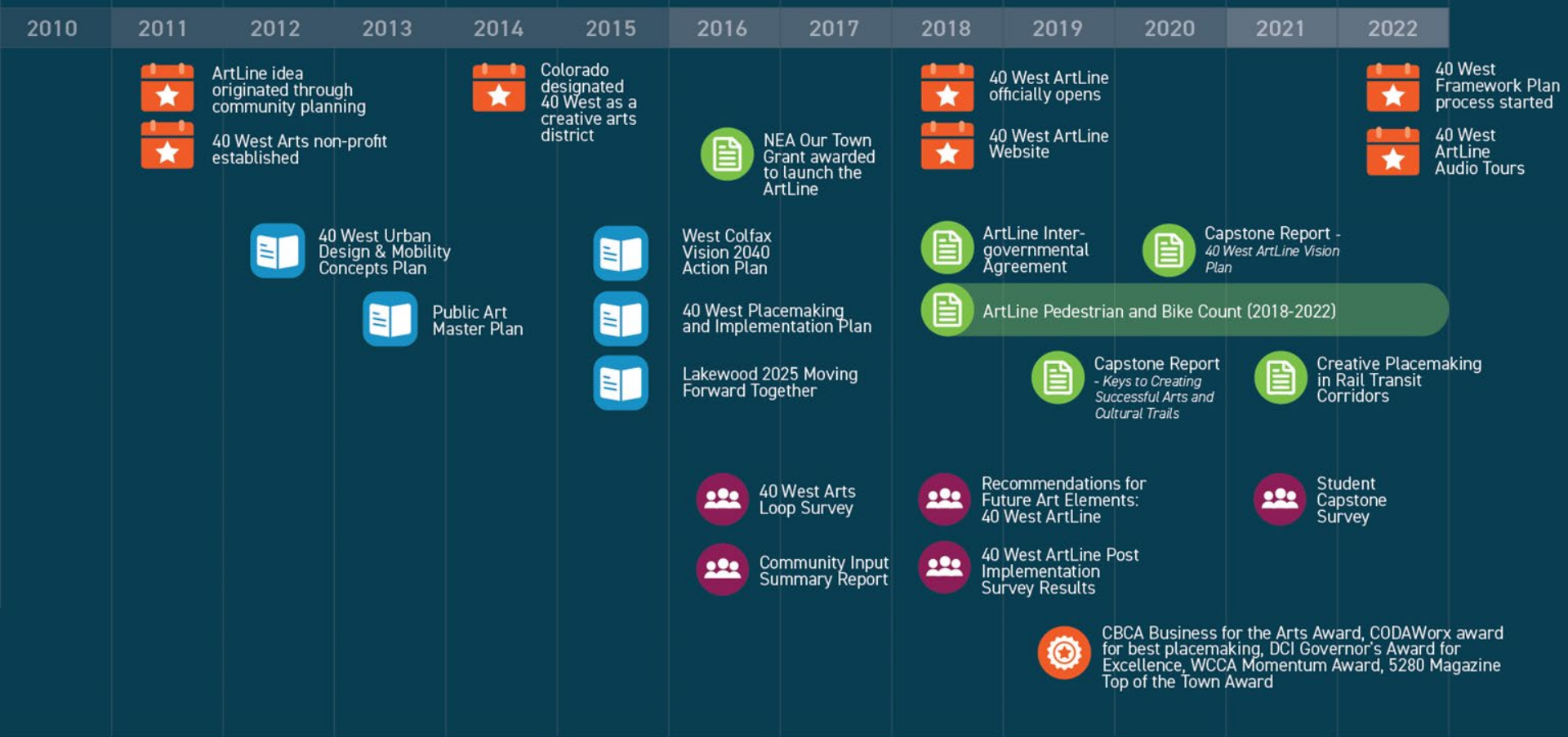


Existing Resources and Community Input Summary

ECONOMIC VIBRANCY

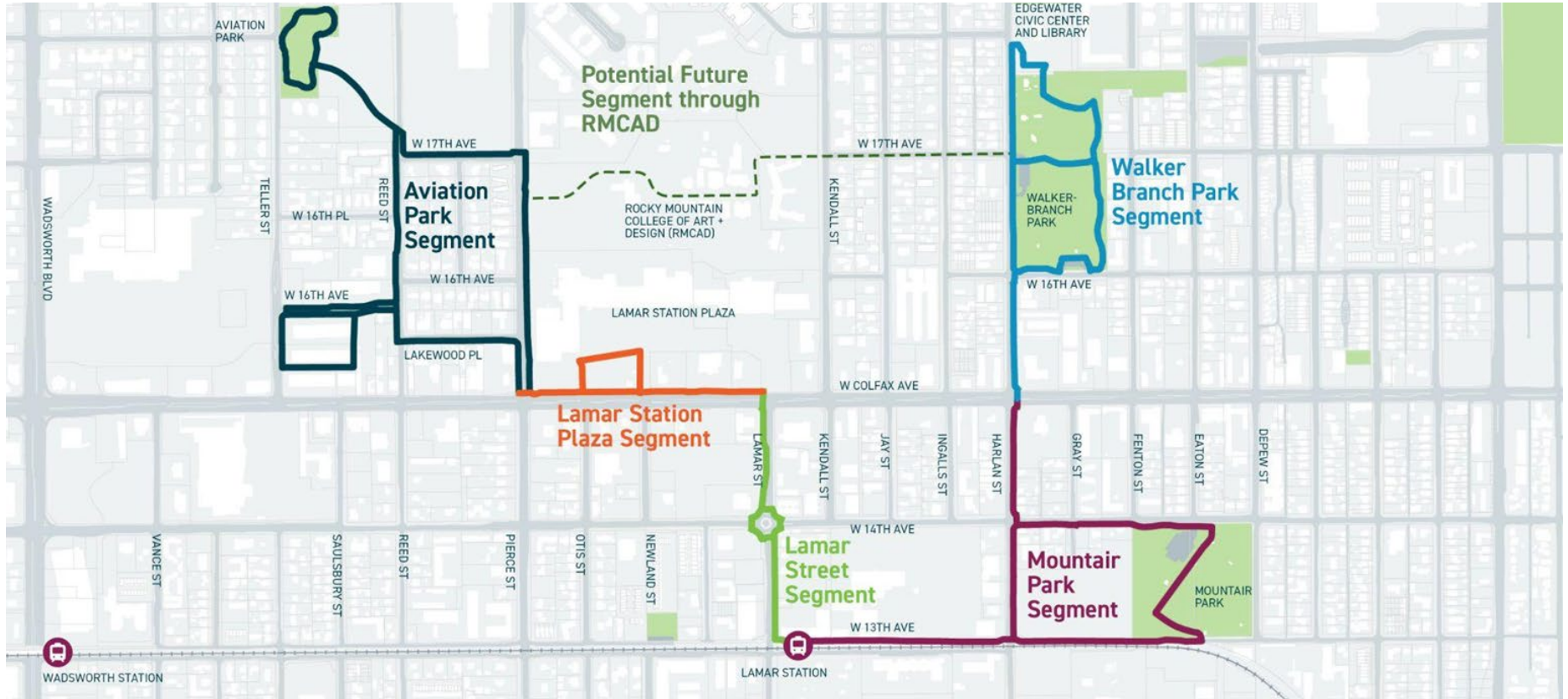
Continue to utilize the ArtLine to enhance economic prosperity and sustainable development efforts.



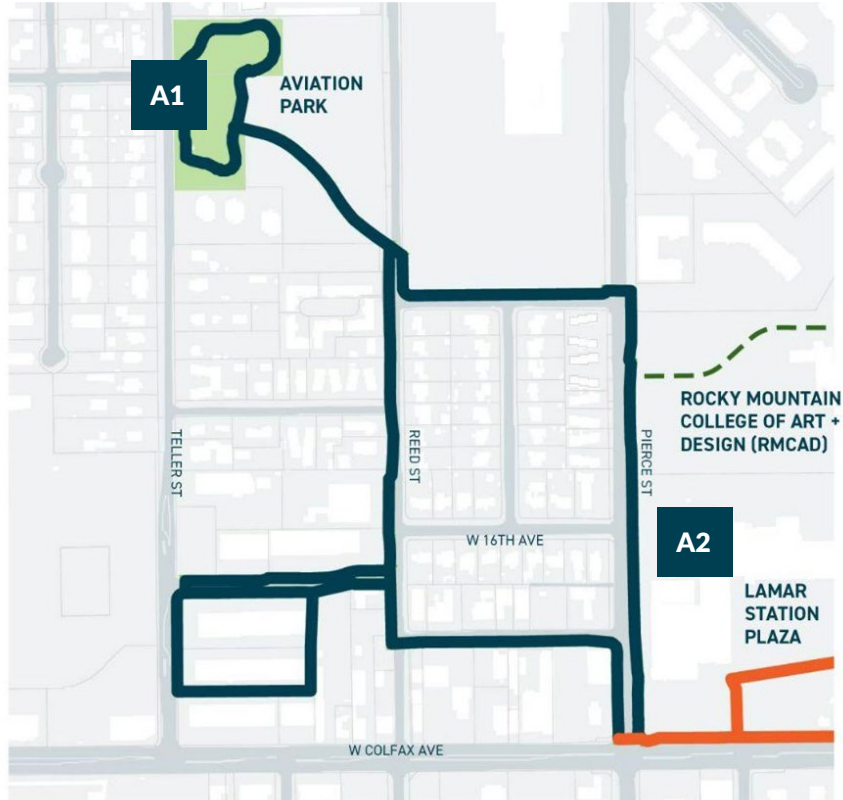
IMPLEMENTATION

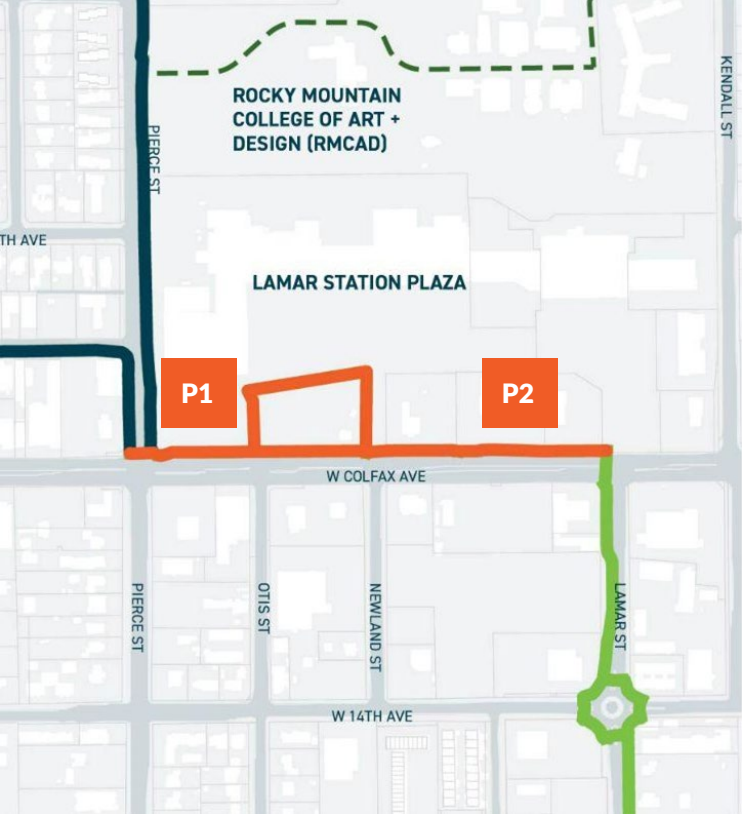
ArtLine Character Segments

Mountair Park Segment

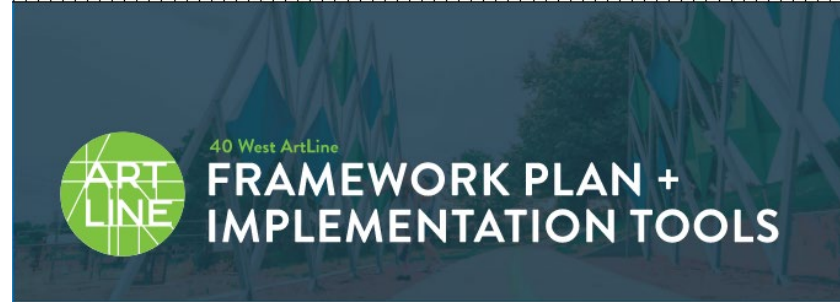
