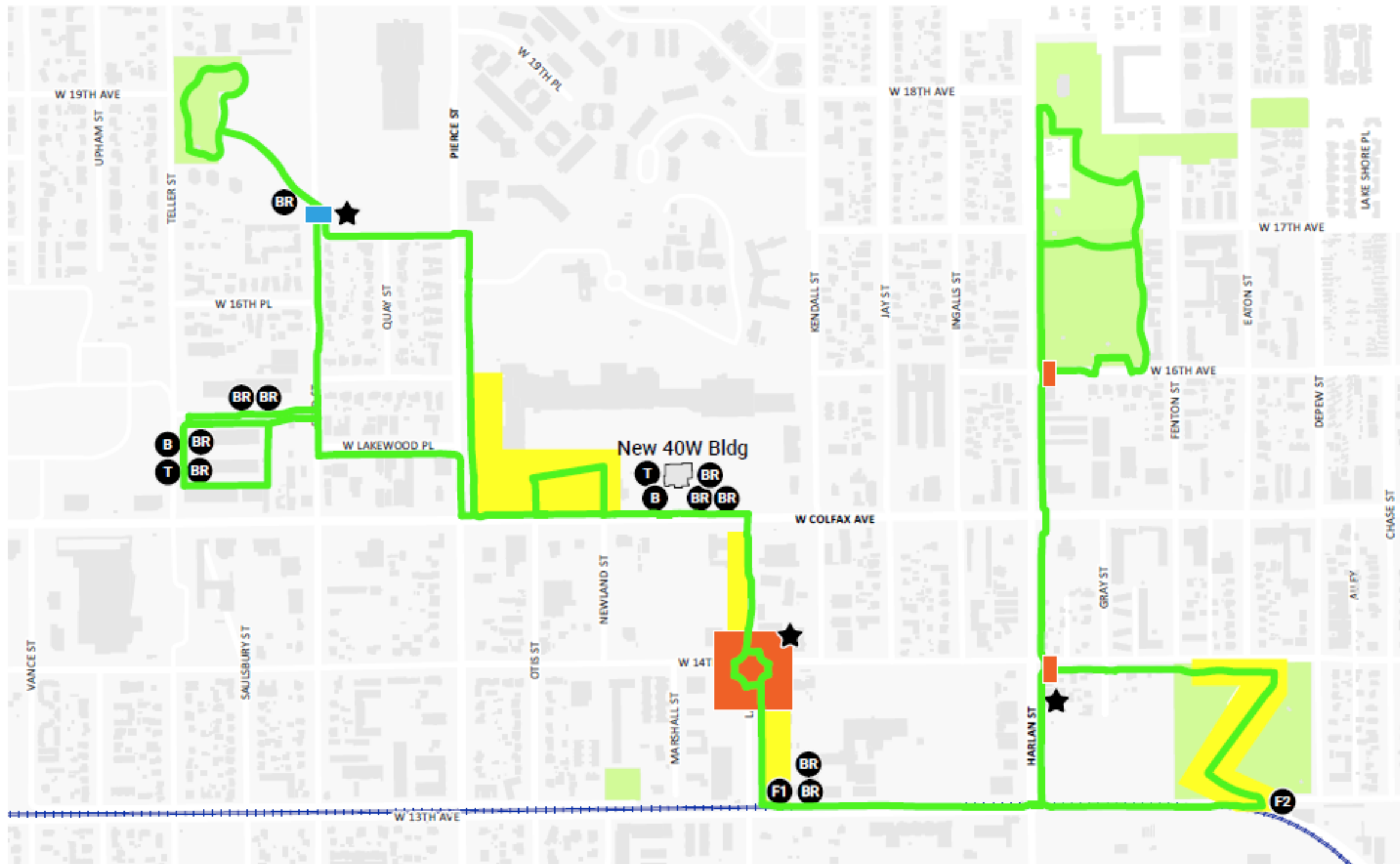

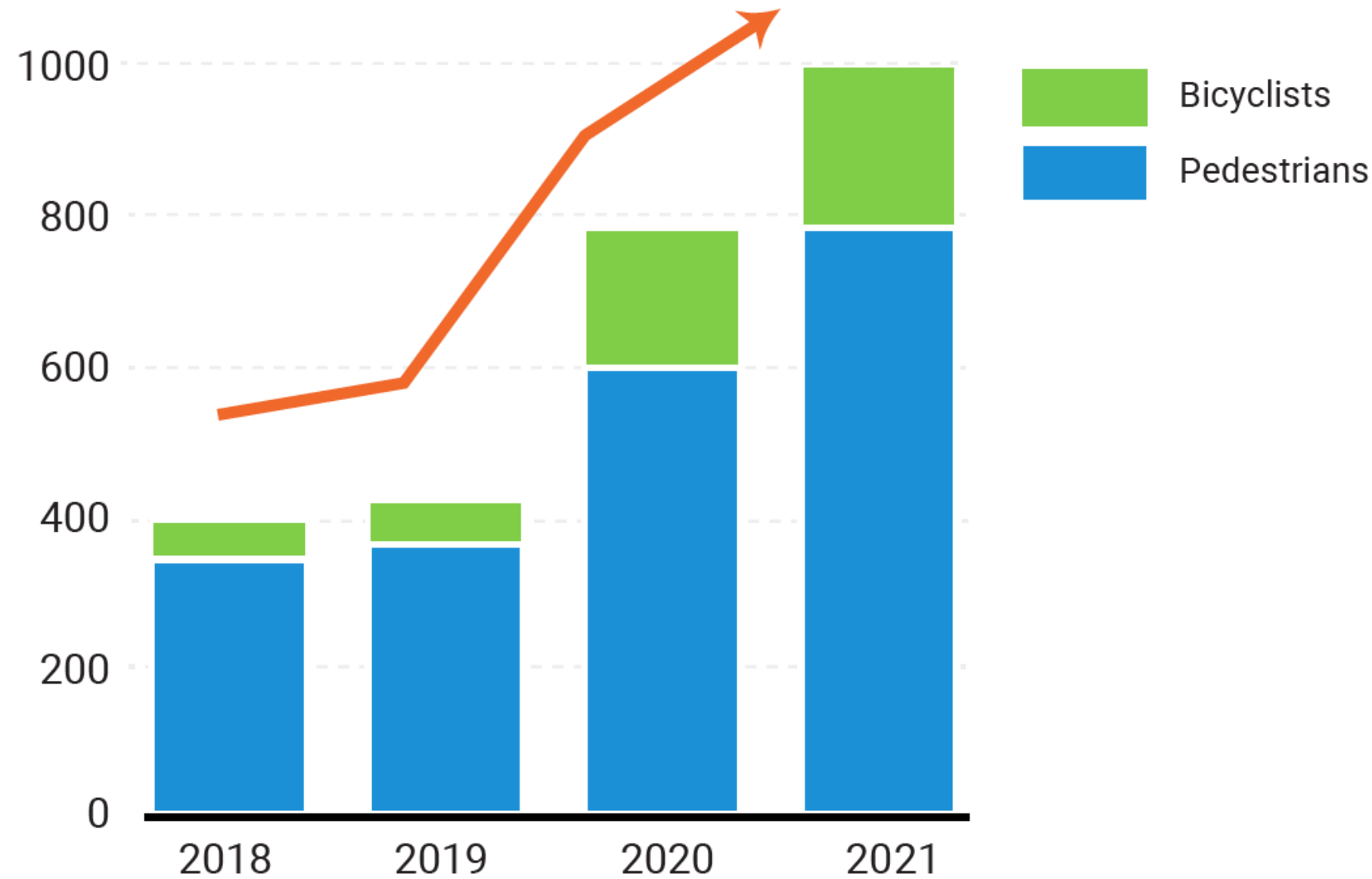

- Document ArtLine vision
- Prioritize multimodal transportation + streetscape improvements
- Conceptualize design treatments
- Ensure tools in place to catalyze and sustain the award-winning project
- Plan will help secure future funding

Project Timeline and Next Steps:

- Developing project scope for approval by CDOT/DRCOG
- Contracting with CDOT/DRCOG
- RFP for consultant team to lead project - late spring 2022
- Community + stakeholder engagement process
- Approximately 12-14 month project
