Bayaud's Paid Transitional DayWorks Program

The Jeffco Employment & Training program is a partnership between Bayaud Enterprises and Jefferson County Workforce Development to provide paid transitional work experience and subsidized training opportunities for individuals experiencing homelessness or affected by COVID.

This project supported, in whole or in part, by federal award number SLFRF0126 awarded to the State of Colorado by the U.S. Department of Treasury.

Jeffco Employment & Training

DayWorks

- Ten (10) week program for participants to work with Employment Specialists/Case Managers to assist in addressing employment hurdles.
- Provide paid transitional work opportunities for individuals experiencing homelessness.
- Crews work up to four days a week for 10 weeks and are allowed to receive supported employment for up to twelve months.

Work & Subsidized Training

- **UPSKILLING:** Up to 140 participant would qualify for upskill training
- ORIENTATION LOCATIONS: Lakewood, Arvada, & Westminster
- **PARTICIPANT WAGES:** \$100/day (\$16.66/hour)
- Three crews of four participants who work four days per week
- Transportation from 1550 Dover St. to worksite and back
- Participants provided breakfast and lunch meals
